The School Governance (Roles, Procedures and Allowances) (England) Regulations 2013 give Governing Bodies the discretion to pay allowances from the school's annual budget allocation to governors for certain allowances which they incur in carrying out their duties:

This was originally referred to the Governors' Resources Committee for consideration and agreement on 13th October 2014. The Committee's recommendation not to adopt an allowances scheme was noted at the Governing Board meeting on 3rd December 2014.

Under the DfE guidance: Maintained Schools Governance Guide, published 7 March 2024 and last updated 2 October 2024, Governing Boards are recommended to review the governor allowances scheme annually.
